

Photo Referee Verification

If you do not have existing photographic identification to validate your application, a Photo Referee must be provided to Dumfries and Galloway Council when you apply. Your application should be made on an application form.

The referee must:

- have no family or personal relationship with, or live with, the applicant (including that of guardian or foster carer)
- be over 25 years of age
- provide a daytime, work telephone number.
- know the applicant and be able to confirm that the applicant is who they claim to be.
- have an occupation that meets the criteria for acceptable Referees who can provide an acceptable countersignature (See attached).
- provide a signature on the application form, and also on the reverse of the photograph which should be endorsed with "I confirm that this is a true likeness of "[Applicant's Name]" and that it is signed and dated by the Referee.
- Consent to be contacted if required to confirm any of the details supplied
- Sign the declaration that includes the caution about the penalty for making a false declaration

PASS-approved referees

Referees must work in a recognised profession or be "a person of good standing in their community":
