1. Reason for Report

Due to the terms of the Chief Constable's statutory notice with regard to transfer of a premises licence application, the Board must, in law, hold a Hearing.

2. Background

- 2.1 Mr Josef Henry Rothmund is the current premises licence holder in respect of the above named premises and, on 16 March 2022, he submitted an application to transfer the premises licence to the Partnership of David and Sarah Henry.
- 2.2 A copy of the application was forwarded to Police Scotland on 16 March 2022.
- 2.3 On 22 March 2022, the Chief Constable responded with a notice advising that the transferee David Henry has been convicted of relevant offences. Said letter also provides additional information and recommends that the transfer be refused (**Appendix**).

3. Determination of the application

- 3.1 As democratically elected individuals, decision making power rests with elected Members and not Council Officers. Whilst Officers can give advice and guidance, they cannot clearly make decisions at Hearings. Ultimately, the Board must come to a lawful decision.
- 3.2 In terms of the law the Board must, having regard to the Chief Constable's notice and the additional information contained therein:
 - If satisfied that a ground for refusal applies, REFUSE THE APPLICATION or
 - If not so satisfied, GRANT THE APPLICATION
- 3.3 The grounds for refusal are:
 - That, having regard to the licensing objectives, the transferee is not a fit and proper person to be the holder of a premises licence;
 - That it is otherwise necessary to refuse the application for the purposes of any
 of the licensing objectives.

4. Recommendation

Members are asked to either GRANT or REFUSE the transfer application.

In terms of Section 33(6)(b)(i) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 (the 2005 Act) I give notice that the transferee David Henry has been convicted of the following relevant offence(s).

For clarity, I can confirm that Sarah Henry has not been convicted of any relevant offence.

I am unable to confirm the existence of any foreign offence in respect of the transferee or any connected person.

OFFICIAL SENSITIVE: POLICE AND PARTNERS

In terms of Section 33(7A) of the 2005 Act the Chief Constable provides the following information which is relevant to consideration by the Licensing Board of the application:-

On 16th July 2021, Police attended at the home address of Mr Henry in relation to an unrelated incident. During this time it was discovered that Mr Henry had an unsecured shotgun within a downstairs wardrobe of the property. As a result his weapons and certificates were seized by suitably trained officers. On checking his Shotgun certificate it was established at this time that it was not signed. Mr Henry was thereafter cautioned and charged for not complying with his shotgun certificate and failing to sign same.

On 21 July 2021, following a family disagreement Mr Henry has left his home address whilst under the influence of alcohol and driven his white coloured Ford Transit van from Portpatrick to Stranraer. Due to Mr Henry's emotional state and the fact he was driving whilst under the influence of alcohol the Police were contacted and the vehicle was later traced in Lidl car park, Stoneykirk Road, Stranraer. Mr Henry was traced nearby and required by Police to provide the details of the driver of the Ford Transit Valtra under the terms of Section 172 of the Road Traffic Act 1988. At this time Mr Henry replied "me". Mr Henry agreed to provide a specimen of breath for a breath test which he subsequently failed.

Mr Henry was arrested and conveyed to Stranraer Police Station where he underwent the drink drive station procedure providing two specimens of breath with the lower reading being 67 micrograms of alcohol in 100 millilitres of breath. The legal limit in Scotland is 22 micrograms per 100 millilitres.

The circumstances surrounding both of Mr Henry's convictions show poor judgement and are concerning given the responsible nature of the position of Premises Licence Holder.

In light of the above, the Chief considers that it is necessary for the purposes of the securing public safety licensing objective that the application for the transfer of the licence to the transferee be refused. The Chief Constable accordingly makes a recommendation to that effect in terms of section 33(7).
