Answers to question 6 A+b Community Asset Transfer Veterans Garden Dumfries

A. What do you want the asset for

Ans: The Veterans Garden would like to express their interest on an asset transfer on land that they have used within The Crichton Campus (the land had been unused for some 10+ years) for the past 4 years and brought back into use including putting a new roof on the sandstone building cultivating the land and in time restore/refurbish the old glasshouses and continue to run the charity The Veterans Garden Dumfries.

B. What benefits will this bring to the community.

Ans: The Veterans Garden provides therapy through gardening for serving and local veterans suffering from PTSD and service related injuries. We also provide local veterans and their families support and advice in a number issues including housing, finances and job related skills.

We also provide our support to all our blue light services and have worked closely with Mid-Park hospital with their inpatient's under care of the hospitals OT's using the garden.

In the 4 years we have worked this land we have worked closely with Dumfries and Galloway Council and other local agencies. We provide visits from local schools and other parties from further afield. The local community have been at the heart off what we do so they have a better understand of us as a charity and what we do. For the past 2 years we have been making mud kitchens and garden tables and chairs for primary schools within the community.
